Anti-Racism Policy

There is no longer Jew nor Greek, there is no longer slave nor free; There is no longer male nor female; For all of you are one in Christ.—Galatians 3:28

Racism is more than individual acts of bigotry or prejudice. Racism is any system, institution, or cultural practice or tradition, which protects or prefers the lives, property, and status of any group which takes power over another, at the expense of other marginalized persons or groups.

First Presbyterian Church of Connersville Indiana (FPC) will not permit or accept any form of Racism. If Racism is seen or suspected, the Clerk of FPC Session should be notified. The Clerk will then notify Session of FPC of the suspected Racism, and Session will investigate. If Session cannot find an acceptable resolution, then Session will notify the Lead Presbyter of Whitewater Valley Presbytery for help and guidance to resolve the situation.

We humbly undertake this work, trusting that the Holy Spirit will be our guide and inspiration.
