Harassment Policy

First Presbyterian Church of Connersville Indiana (FPC), is committed to an environment free from bullying, harassment and sexual harassment. FPC requires all employees, members and contractors to refrain from bullying, harassment and sexual harassing anyone including other co-workers, other members, volunteers and the general public.

In general, harassment of any kind is unwanted unsolicited conduct that could interfere with work performance or create a hostile or uncomfortable environment. Harassment includes, but is not limited to Verbal (jokes, insults, degrading sexual remarks) and Non-Verbal (gestures, staring, touching, hugging).

Any complaint of harassment should be given first to the Clerk of Session of FPC. The Clerk will then alert the full Session of FPC. If the Session of FPC cannot find an acceptable resolution, then Session of FPC will notify the Lead Presbyter of Whitewater Presbytery for help and direction.
